If a constituency is shaded blue, and the electorate is shown in blue in the constituency list, it indicates that the boundary has been revised from our Initial Proposals. In such cases, if the numbered map label and name in the list are also blue, this means that the name has also been changed from our Initial Proposals.

If a constituency is not shaded blue, the boundary of that constituency has not been revised from our Initial Proposals. However, in such cases, if both the numbered map label and the name of the constituency in the list are shown in blue, this means that the name alone has been changed from our Initial Proposals.
