Initial/revised proposals overview

1. The London region was allocated 68 constituencies under the initial and revised proposals, a reduction of five from the existing allocation. In formulating the initial and revised proposals the Commission decided to construct constituencies using the following sub-regions:

- Under the initial proposals four of the existing 73 constituencies were unchanged. The revised proposals retained six of the existing constituencies unchanged. Under both sets of proposals no constituency crossed the River Thames.
 However we did propose one constituency that crossed the River Lee - Bow and Canning Town.
- 3. Throughout the region, changes had to be made to accommodate the reduction in the number of constituencies and to ensure that every proposed constituency had an electorate within 5% of the electoral quota. In formulating the initial proposals, the Commission sought not to divide wards between constituencies and looked to configure a pattern of constituencies based on whole wards. This limited the number of valid options and meant some existing constituencies had to be altered, that otherwise might not have needed to be changed.

4. In response to the consultation on the initial proposals and secondary consultation the Commission received over 9,000 representations regarding London. These representations commented on most parts of the region, with the main issues being:

North Thames

- the proposed constituency in Enfield borough Enfield, Southgate. Respondents objected to this existing constituency being split across five new constituencies
- the proposed Hammersmith and Fulham constituency a large number of residents objected to the Shepherd's Bush area being included in a constituency with Ealing
- the proposed Hampstead and Golders Green constituency the second consultation phase resulted in a large number of objections to this proposed constituency. Concerns centred around the division of Kilburn along the Kilburn High Road
- the proposed constituencies in Walthamstow objections in the main concerned the Walthamstow area, now comprising of three different constituencies

South Thames

• the proposed constituencies in the London Borough of Merton - respondents objected to changes made to the existing pattern of constituencies in Wimbledon, Mitcham and Morden

- the proposed constituencies in Croydon there was significant opposition to the ward of Purley being included in the Croydon Central constituency; respondents argued there are strong local ties between Purley and the other wards in the Croydon South constituency
- the proposed Woolwich constituency the majority of residents from St Michael's and Lesnes Abbey wards objected to being included in the Woolwich constituency. Three campaigns emerged as a result.
- 5. In considering the evidence received, the Commission altered 72% of constituencies in London.

Number of representations received

6. In the London region, the Commission received a total of 2,390 representations during consultation on the revised proposals, bringing the total number of representations for this region to 11,764. This number included all those who gave evidence at the public hearings. There were also a number of duplicate representations within this total, as well as representations that made general comments that did not have any bearing on the substance of the initial proposals.

7. While many of the representations can be categorised as opposing the Commission's revised proposals, there has been a substantial amount of support for certain constituencies across the whole region. These include, but are not limited to, Cities of London and Westminster, Kensington and Chelsea, Hampstead and Golders Green, Tottenham, Battersea, Bermondsey and Old Southwark, Tooting and Balham, Kingston and Surbiton, Twickenham, Richmond Park, and Wimbledon.

Campaigns

8. As expected, throughout the region, representations from a number of organised campaigns were received. In the London region, these were as follows:-

9. During the previous consultations the Commission received 23 campaigns in relation to London. Of these, the campaign titled Hammersmith and Shepherd's Bush belong together was similar to the campaign received during an earlier consultation, which was titled Shepherd's Bush united in a single constituency.

Major issues

10. Major issues that drew objection were as follows:-

North Thames

- Opposition to the revised Dagenham and Rainham, and Romford constituencies
- There continues to be opposition to the revised Finchley and Enfield Southgate constituency
- We received some opposition to the proposed constituencies in the LB of Harrow and LB of Hillingdon.
- Opposition to the proposed constituencies of Hillingdon and Uxbridge, Hayes and Harlington, Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner, Harrow North, Harrow South and Kenton, and Ealing North
- The proposal for a near coterminous Hammersmith constituency and the inclusion of four Shepherd's Bush wards in a Willesden constituency has received substantial opposition

South Thames

- Opposition to the proposal to include the Belmont ward in a Carshalton and Wallington constituency.
- While there has been support for the revised Wimbledon constituency, there has been some opposition to the inclusion of the Roehampton and Putney Heath ward in the constituency.
- There continues to be opposition to the proposed Bexley and Sidcup, and Erith and Crayford constituencies.

Final recommendations

11. In light the of the representations and evidence received we have considered whether the revised proposals should be changed.

12. The final recommendations have been formulated on the same sub-regions used as the initial and revised proposals. No counter-proposals were received during consultation on the revised proposals which suggested alternative sub-regions.

13. Under the final recommendations six of the existing constituencies are unchanged. In the North Thames sub-region we have been able to increase the number of existing constituencies retained to four. We still however proposed one constituency split across three local authorities. In the South Thames sub-region we continue to propose two existing constituencies remain unchanged: Richmond Park, and Kingston and Surbiton. There are now no constituencies in the South Thames sub-region split across three or more local authorities.

Overview

14. In our initial and revised proposals, we divided the London region into two sub-regions: North Thames (with 42 constituencies) and South Thames (with 26). No constituencies crossed the Thames. In general, strong support was received for our two sub-regions throughout all consultation periods and we recommend the sub-regions of North Thames and South Thames as part of the final recommendations.

- 15. Our initial and revised proposals also proposed crossing the River Lee between Tower Hamlets and Newham, at the south of its course, rather than the north (between Edmonton in Enfield and Chingford in Waltham Forest). When recommending this as part of its initial proposals, the Commission was cognisant of the lessons learned from the previous 2013 Review of boundaries, where strong opposition was voiced to a crossing in the north of the river's course in London. Again, general support was received for this decision, and most major counter-proposals for North Thames were based on retaining the River Lea and the surrounding estuaries as a boundary between Edmonton and Waltham Forest. We therefore, recommend retaining this split in the final recommendations.
- 16. A number of split-ward proposals were put to us during the consultation stages, including from political parties and members of the public. These ward-splits were all to try to avoid breaking local ties. As part of the revised proposals, Commissioners recommend one ward split in London, the ward of Brunswick Park (divided between the Chipping Barnet and Finchley and Enfield Southgate constituencies). This ward split was suggested by the Secretariat in order to help solve the issues raised by respondents. During consultation on the revised proposals, an alternative ward split has been suggested in this part of London, and further ward splits have been suggested in other parts of the region. We recommend that the final recommendations for London continue to have one ward split, although recommend an alternative to the revised proposals. This is detailed later in this report and will be outlined in the presentation to Commissioners.

North Thames sub region

17. Of the existing 45 constituencies north of the river, 14 have electorates within 5% of the electoral quota: Barking, Bethnal Green and Bow, Brent Central, Chipping Barnet, Ealing North, Hackney North and Stoke Newington, Hackney South and Shoreditch, Hampstead and Kilburn, Hornchurch and Upminster, Hornsey and Wood Green, Ilford South,

Poplar and Limehouse, Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner, and Twickenham. Of the remaining constituencies, 25 have electorates that are below the 5% limit, and six are above. Our initial proposals were for 42 constituencies, retaining only two (Hornchurch and Upminster, and Twickenham) of the existing constituencies unchanged. Our revised proposals were for 42 constituencies, retaining four (Hornchurch and Upminster, Islington South, Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner, and Twickenham) of the existing constituencies unchanged.

North Thames sub region - North East London

- 18. The revised proposals in this part of the sub-region amended all constituencies put forward as part of the initial proposals. Objections had previously been received which suggested that the initial proposals divided the centre of Walthamstow between constituencies, and objected to the configuration of the Dagenham and Rainham constituency. A number of counter-proposals were received to the initial proposals, including some which suggested the division of the Eastbrook ward. The revised proposals were for the constituencies of Romford, Hornchurch and Upminster, Dagenham and Rainham, Ilford North and Wanstead, Ilford South, Barking and Beckton, Leyton and Stratford, Stepney and Bow, Poplar and Canning Town, Walthamstow, and Chingford and Woodford Green. Our revised proposals largely addressed the issues raised by the initial proposals in the Walthamstow, Chingford and Ilford areas. As part of the revised proposals the existing constituencies of Hornchurch and Upminster, and Ilford South were both retained unchanged.
- 19. The revised proposals have largely been supported by respondents during the recent consultation. Respondents particularly supported the changes made to the Walthamstow constituency and the retention of the existing Ilford South constituency. Some objections have been received commenting on the Eastbrook ward, with some counter-proposals suggesting this ward should be divided between the Dagenham and Rainham, and Romford constituencies. A number of alternative constituency names have also been suggested.

Recommendations

20. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this part of the sub-region. We consider that an exceptional or compelling case has not been made which would warrant the division of the Eastbrook ward between constituencies, particularly as it would create an orphan polling district. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

North Thames sub region - North and North West London

- 21. The revised proposals amended the majority of constituencies in the north of this area but only modified two constituencies further south in the area. During consultation on the initial proposals significant objections were received to the division of the existing Enfield, Southgate constituency between five proposed constituencies, and the Borough of Enfield also split between five constituencies. A number of counter-proposals were received that attempted to address this issue, but with the consequence of splitting the Tottenham area. Some counter-proposals were also received which proposed dividing the proposed Edmonton constituency which had been supported during the initial consultation.
- 22. Given the opposition received the assistant commissioners investigated a number of alternative patterns of constituencies, and visited the area to observe the area on the ground. They proposed changes to the initially proposed constituencies of Chipping Barnet and Mill Hill, Finchley and Southgate, Hornsey and Wood Green, Tottenham and Hendon. Assistant commissioners suggested a Finchley and Enfield Southgate constituency that divided the existing constituency between four constituencies and ensured that the Cockfosters ward was included in the constituency. As part of this proposal it was recommended that the Brunswick Park ward be divided between the Finchley and Enfield

Southgate, and Chipping Barnet constituencies. Consequently, it was proposed that the Mill Hill ward be included in the Hendon constituency to ensure it was within the permitted electorate range.

- 23. Assistant Commissioners also recommended changes to the initially proposed Tottenham, and Hornsey and Wood Green constituencies. They proposed that the Stroud Green ward be included in the Hornsey and Wood Green constituency, given that the East Coast railway line formed a clear boundary in the east of this ward. Consequently, it was proposed that the Woodside ward be included in the Tottenham constituency.
- 24. During consultation on the initial proposals some opposition was received to the proposed Queen's Park and Regent's Park constituency. Respondents considered that the areas were divided by the A5. Counter-proposals were received, including the suggestion that Regent's Park ward (City of Westminster) should be included in a Cities of London and Westminster constituency. Those who recommended this proposal considered that Regent's Park had shared interests with the Marylebone area to the south of the Marylebone Road (A501). To ensure constituencies were within the permitted electoral range, respondents considered that the Hyde Park and Lancaster Gate wards should be transferred from the Cities of London and Westminster constituency to the Queen's Park constituency. Respondents considered that the A402 provided a clear boundary in the south and these areas shared community interests with Bayswater and Little Venice. This pattern of constituencies were included in the revised proposals albeit with the Queen's Park and Regent's Park constituency remaned Kilburn.
- 25. During consultation on the revised proposals the alternative pattern of constituencies in this area have broadly been supported. Some opposition has been received to the proposed re-configured Enfield and Southgate constituencies with respondents suggesting that it continues to divide the Enfield Southgate area between constituencies. Some respondents have commented on the proposed split of the Brunswick Park ward with some supporting the configuration.

However, some respondents consider that the revised proposals result in the division of Finchley between constituencies. A counter-proposal has been received to unite Finchley with Chipping Barnet in a constituency. This counter-proposals would not divide the Brunswick Park ward but suggests that the Oakleigh ward be divided between constituencies and that the East Barnet ward be included in a constituency with Enfield Southgate. This counter-proposal is self-contained and would not require amendments to adjacent constituencies.

26. The revised proposals for the remaining constituencies in this part of London were broadly supported. Some opposition was received to the changes to the existing Islington constituencies, however, no new counter-proposals were received. Some comments were received which suggested alternative constituency names.

Recommendations

- 27. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend changes to the revised proposals for the constituencies of Finchley and Enfield Southgate, and Chipping Barnet. We recommend the counter-proposal that divides the Oakleigh ward between constituencies. This proposal would unite the Finchley wards in a Chipping Barnet constituency. This proposal would not divide the Brunswick Park ward and would include the East Barnet ward in a constituency with Enfield Southgate. As will be outlined in the presentation to commissioners, we will detail further this counter-proposal.
- 28. We do not recommend any further changes to constituencies in this part of the region. However, we do recommend five constituency name changes; Hornsey and Wood Green to Hornsey; Hackney Central to Hackney; Islington to Islington South and Finsbury; Finchley and Enfield Southgate to Enfield Southgate and East Barnet; and Chipping Barnet to

Chipping Barnet and Finchley. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

North Thames sub-region - Central and West London

- 29. The initial proposals in the north west of London were largely opposed by respondents. A number of concerns were raised regarding the proposed Wembley and Harrow on the Hill constituency, with respondents indicating that the two areas did not share a community of interest. Opposition was also received to the constituencies of Hillingdon and Uxbridge, and Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner. Respondents considered that the existing Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner constituency should be retained unchanged and that minor changes could be made to the existing Uxbridge and South Ruislip constituency.
- 30. Opposition was also received to the proposed Ealing Central and Shepherd's Bush constituency. The majority of respondents considered that Shepherd's Bush should be included in a constituency with Hammersmith rather than Ealing. Counter-proposals were received which proposed Shepherd's Bush being included in either a Hammersmith constituency or a Willesden constituency. It was noted that counter-proposals to include Shepherd's Bush in a constituency with Hammersmith would require consequential changes to the proposed Kensington and Chelsea constituency. Under the initial proposals this constituency was coterminous with the Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and it was largely supported in representations. Some counter-proposals suggested dividing the Kensington and Chelsea constituency, which received significant opposition.
- 31. There was further opposition to the proposed Ealing Central and Shepherd's Bush constituency, particularly that it divided the area of West Ealing from Ealing Common and Ealing Broadway.

- 32. The proposed constituencies of Hayes and Harlington, Feltham and Hounslow, Brentford and Chiswick, and Twickenham were largely supported.
- 33. The revised proposals modified the majority of constituencies in this part of the region. The revised proposals included the existing Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner constituency, and sought to address respondents' concerns about the division of Harrow in reconfigured constituencies of Harrow North, Harrow South and Kenton, Wembley, and Greenford and Sudbury. The revised proposals also suggested changes to the constituencies of Southall and Heston, Ealing and Acton, Willesden and Shepherd's Bush in order to not divide Ealing between constituencies. No changes were proposed to the constituencies of Kensington and Chelsea or Hammersmith and Fulham. Assistant commissioners recognised that opposition had been received to the proposed Hammersmith and Fulham constituency but that counter-proposals resulted in a number of changes to the adjacent Kensington and Chelsea constituency, which had been supported.
- 34. During consultation on the revised proposals, the Commission has received a mixture of support and opposition to the proposed pattern of constituencies. A counter-proposal was received which suggested an alternative pattern for five constituencies in this part of London including changes to the existing Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner constituency. A counter-proposal was received which suggested changes to the proposed constituencies of Harrow North, and Harrow South and Kenton. This counter-proposals suggested that the Queensbury ward (Harrow LB) be included in the Harrow North constituency, and included the Rayners Lane ward in the Harrow South and Kenton constituency. Supporters of this proposal considered it better reflected community ties in the area.

- 35. A counter-proposal was also received for the Greenford and Sudbury, and Wembley constituencies. It was suggested that the Alperton ward be included in the Greenford and Sudbury constituency, and the Northwick Park ward be included in the Wembley constituency. Supporters of this proposal considered it better reflected community ties in the area.
- 36. Opposition continued to be received for the proposed Hammersmith and Fulham constituency, with respondents concerned that it did not reflect the community ties between Hammersmith and Shepherd's Bush. Counter-proposals were suggested which proposed similar configurations to those received during earlier consultations which would result in changes to adjacent constituencies, including the Kensington and Chelsea constituency, which has been supported.

Recommendations

- 37. As will be outlined in the presentation to commissioners, having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this part of the sub-region. We note the different counter-proposals received for Harrow North, Harrow South and Kenton, Wembley and Greenford and Sudbury. However, we consider that no new or compelling evidence has been received to modify the revised proposals.
- 38. Similarly, we note the continued objection to the proposed Hammersmith and Fulham, and Willesden and Shepherd's Bush constituencies, with opponents concerned that this pattern of constituencies breaks community ties. We have investigated alternatives but note that changes would be required to adjacent constituencies, including that of Kensington and Chelsea, which has otherwise been supported. Given that no new or compelling evidence has been received we recommend no changes to these proposed constituencies. However, we do recommended four constituency name changes; Ealing and Acton to Ealing Central and Acton; Greenford and Sudbury to Ealing North and

Sudbury; Hillingdon and Uxbridge to Uxbridge and Northolt; and Kilburn to Paddington and Queen's Park. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

South Thames sub-region

39. Of the existing 28 constituencies south of the river, six have electorates that are within the permitted electoral range: Croydon Central; Dulwich and West Norwood; Kingston and Surbiton; Richmond Park; Tooting; and Vauxhall. Of the remaining constituencies, 18 have electorates that are below the 5% limit, and two are above. Our initial proposals were for 26 constituencies, retaining only two (Kingston and Surbiton, and Richmond Park) of the existing constituencies unchanged. Our revised proposals were for 26 constituencies, retaining two (Kingston and Surbiton, and Richmond Park) of the existing constituencies unchanged. Our final proposals were for 26 constituencies, retaining the same constituencies unchanged.

South Thames sub region - East and South East

40. The initial proposals in the eastern part of the sub-region were largely opposed. Respondents opposed the inclusion of the Bexley Borough wards of St Michael's and Lesnes Abbey in the Woolwich constituency. Respondents considered that these wards were part of the Erith area and should be included in the same constituency. A number of counter-proposals were received that included either both or one of the wards in the Erith and Crayford constituency. A counter-proposal was also received that suggested dividing the Lesnes Abbey ward (polling district, LA1E) between constituencies.

- 41. To the south of Bexley, the proposed constituencies of Orpington, and Bromley and Chislehurst were largely supported. Opposition was received to the proposed Beckenham constituency, particularly that it included the Croydon Borough ward of Shirley. Respondents highlighted that the Shirley community is spread across three wards, those of Shirley, Ashburton, and Heathfield. They considered that all three wards should be included in a Croydon based constituency.
- 42. Opposition was also received to the initial proposals for South Croydon. Under the initial proposals the wards of Coulsdon West, Coulsdon East, and Kenley were included in a Croydon South constituency. Respondents considered that these wards were separated from other parts of the proposed Croydon South constituency by the A22.
- 43. The revised proposals included changes to constituencies in the area of Bexley, Woolwich, Eltham, Croydon and Beckenham. In the north-east of this sub-region, the revised proposals were for constituencies of Bexley and Sidcup, Eltham and Welling, Erith and Crayford, and Woolwich. These constituencies reflected the evidence received concerning the St Michael's and Lesnes Abbey wards which were included in the Erith and Crayford constituencies under the revised proposals.
- 44. The revised proposals also included reconfigured constituencies of Beckenham, Croydon South East, Croydon South West, and Norwood and Thornton Heath. This pattern of constituencies sought to reflect the evidence regarding the division of Shirley between constituencies, and reflected the community ties between Coulsdon and Purley.
- 45. The revised proposals in this part of the sub-region have largely been supported. Some counter-proposals have been received for the constituencies of Bexley and Sidcup, and Erith and Crayford, and for London Borough of Croydon. A counter-proposal has been received which suggests the inclusion of the Barnehurst, Crayford and North End wards in

- the Bexley and Sidcup constituency, and the Christchurch, and Danson Park wards in a Erith constituency. Supporters of this counter-proposal consider it better reflects community ties.
- 46. The counter-proposal for Croydon largely focused on the inclusion of the Broad Green ward in a Croydon constituency rather than being included in the Mitcham and Norbury constituency as it was under the revised proposal. Supporters of this counter-proposal indicated that Croydon West railway station was in the Broad Green ward. The counter-proposal would require modifications to adjacent constituencies including separating parts of Coulsdon from Purley in reconfigured constituencies.

Recommendations

47. As will be outlined in the presentation to Commissioners, having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this part of the sub-region. We consider that the counter-proposal in the Croydon area would divide local ties between Coulsdon and Purley. We have investigated the counter-proposal for Bexley and Erith and do not recommend this configuration of constituencies. We consider that the alternative proposal divides the Bexleyheath area between constituencies. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

South Thames sub region - West, South West and Central

48. The revised proposals modified the majority of the constituencies in this sub-region. The constituencies of Richmond Park, Kingston and Surbiton, Sutton and Cheam, and Carshalton and Wallington were unchanged under the revised proposals.

- 49. The initial proposals covering the areas of Wimbledon, Mitcham, and Merton received significant opposition during both consultations. The initial proposals included the centre of Wimbledon in a Merton and Wimbledon Central constituency and the wards of Village and Wimbledon Park in a Wimbledon Common and Putney constituency. Opposition was received to these proposals, particularly the division of Wimbledon between constituencies. Respondents highlighted that the wards of Village and Wimbledon Park were an integral part of the Wimbledon community
- 50. Significant opposition was also received to the proposed Merton and Wimbledon, and Streatham and Mitcham constituencies. Respondents opposed the existing Mitcham and Morden constituency being divided between four constituencies, and the borough of Merton being divided between five constituencies. Particular concern was voiced about the breaking of local ties in the centre of Mitcham, as it was argued that the wards that form the centre of Mitcham were being split between three constituencies
- 51. A number of counter-proposals were received which resolved the opposition to the Wimbledon, Mitcham, and Merton constituencies. However, many of the counter-proposals largely resolved individual areas i.e. resolving the concerns raised regarding Wimbledon required further changes to the constituencies covering Mitcham and Morden.
- 52. The revised proposals included an alternative configuration for the constituencies covering Wimbledon, Mitcham and Merton. The Wimbledon constituency was expanded to include the wards of Wimbledon Park, Village, and Roehampton and Putney Heath. A Mitcham and Norbury constituency was proposed which sought to not divide Mitcham between constituencies. Revised proposals were also put forward for the constituencies of Tooting, and Wandsworth and Putney.

- 53. The revised proposals also included different configurations of constituencies in the centre of this sub-region. The revised proposals were for constituencies of Battersea and Clapham, Brixton and Vauxhall, Camberwell and Peckham, Dulwich and Sydenham, Greenwich and Deptford, Lewisham and Catford, and Streatham and Brixton South. This pattern of constituencies sought to reflect evidence received during the consultation periods.
- 54. The revised proposals in this part of the South Thames have broadly been supported. The Wimbledon constituency has been supported by Wimbledon respondents considering it unites the area, however, some opposition has been received to the inclusion of the Roehampton and Putney Heath ward, with respondents indicating this area has closer ties with Putney and Wandsworth rather than Wimbledon. A counter-proposal has been received which includes the Roehampton and Putney Heath ward in the Putney and Wandsworth constituency, but to do so suggests dividing the Earlsfield ward between that constituency and Wimbledon to ensure both are within the permitted electorate range. Some support has been received for the revised Mitcham and Norbury constituency, although some respondent consider it could be improved by the inclusion of the Colliers Wood ward.
- 55. A counter-proposal has been received which suggests modifications to the constituencies of Camberwell and Peckham, and Dulwich and Sydenham. The respondent suggests that the South Camberwell ward be included in the Dulwich and Sydenham constituency and proposes the Peckham Rye ward be included in the Camberwell and Peckham constituency. The respondent considers this better reflects community ties in the Peckham area. A further counter-proposal has also been received for the Dulwich and Sydenham constituency. This second counter-proposal suggests the inclusion of the Bellingham ward in the Dulwich and Sydenham constituency and the transfer of the Crofton Park ward to the Lewisham and Catford constituency.

Recommendations

- 56. As will be outlined to commissioners in the presentation, having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we are persuaded by the counter-proposal to include the Bellingham ward in the Dulwich and Sydenham constituency and the Crofton Park ward in the Lewisham and Catford constituency. We consider this modification reflects the community ties evidence received and results in constituencies more closer aligned to the existing pattern. We are not persuaded by the arguments to modify the boundary between Dulwich and Sydenham, and Camberwell and Peckham.
- 57. We have also considered the counter-proposal for the Wimbledon, and Wandsworth and Putney constituencies. we recognise the benefit of including the Roehampton and Putney Heath ward in the Wandsworth and Putney constituency but note that this can only be achieved by dividing the Earlsfield ward. We consider that an exceptional and compelling case has not been made to divide this ward between constituencies and that dividing the ward is likely to break community ties. Therefore, we recommend no changes to the boundaries of these or any other constituencies in this part of the South Thames sub-region.
- 58. We do recommended three constituency name changes; Streatham and Brixton South to Streatham and Brixton Hill; Tooting to Tooting and Balham; and Wandsworth and Putney to Putney and Wandsworth Town. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A
