Initial/revised proposals overview

1. The South East region was allocated 83 constituencies under the initial and revised proposals, a reduction of one from the existing allocation. In formulating the initial and revised proposals the Commission decided to construct constituencies using the following sub-regions:

2. Under the initial proposals 15 of the existing 84 constituencies were completely unchanged. The revised proposals retained 20 of the existing constituencies unchanged. Under the initial proposals it was proposed to have one constituency that crossed county boundaries - between East Sussex and Kent. Under the revised proposals, two further constituencies crossed county boundaries, one between Berkshire and Surrey, and one between East Sussex and Kent.

### Number of representations received

3. In response to the consultation on the initial proposals and secondary consultation the Commission received over 2,900 representations regarding the South East region. These representations commented on most parts of the region, with the main issues being:
  - In Hampshire, the proposed transfer of the two Church Crookham wards to Aldershot constituency, and the proposal to transfer rural wards south of Winchester to the Test Valley constituency;
  - In Milton Keynes, the proposal to transfer the ward of Wolverton to a largely rural Buckingham constituency;
  - In Berkshire, the proposal to transfer Slough's Chalvey ward to the Windsor constituency, and in Reading both the proposed inclusion of Mapledurham ward in Reading West, and the splitting of the Maiden Erlegh ward from the Lower Earley area;
  - In Medway, the proposal to transfer Higham ward from Gravesham to Rochester and Strood constituency, with concerns in Thanet focused on the scale of change proposed; and
  - In Brighton and Hove, the distribution of Hove wards across two constituencies.
4. In considering the evidence received, the Commission altered 51% of constituencies in the South East region: two of these constituencies were only subject to a change of name.
5. In the South East region, the Commission received a total of 2,511 representations during consultation on the revised proposals, bringing the total number of representations for this region to 5,438. This number includes all those who gave evidence at the public hearings. There were also a number of duplicate representations within this total, as well as

representations that made general comments that did not have any bearing on the substance of the initial or revised proposals.

6. While many of the representations can be categorised as opposing the Commission’s revised proposals, there has been a degree of support for certain constituencies across the whole region. These include, but are not limited to, Chatham and The Mallings, Eastbourne, Gillingham and Rainham, Hastings and Rye, and across the West Sussex sub-region.

Campaigns

7. As expected, throughout the region, representations from a number of organised campaigns were received. In the South East region, these were as follows:-

8. During the previous consultations the Commission received 20 campaigns in relation to the South East region. Of these, the first four listed above are similar to other campaigns received during earlier consultations.

#### Major issues

9. Major issues that drew objection were as follows:-

##### Berkshire and Surrey

- Moving Slough's Chalvey ward to the Windsor constituency, to increase the electors in Windsor.
- The inclusion of Mapledurham ward in Reading West, from which it is detached, to increase electors in Reading West.
- The splitting of the Maiden Erlegh ward from the Lower Earley area, to increase electors in Reading East.
- Moving Windlesham ward from Surrey Heath to Windsor, across the Berkshire/Surrey boundary, to increase electors in Windsor.
- Moving Bucklebury and Basildon wards from Newbury to Reading West, to reduce electors in Newbury and increase them in Reading West.

- Moving Thorpe ward from Runnymede and Weybridge to Spelthorne, to increase electors in Spelthorne. Many representations suggested Egham Hythe as an alternative, but this leaves Runnymede and Weybridge with too few electors.
- Moving Hersham South ward from Esher and Walton to Runnymede and Weybridge, to reduce electors in Esher and Walton, and increase electors in Runnymede and Weybridge.

#### Brighton and Hove, East Sussex, Kent, and Medway

- The distribution of Hove wards across two constituencies.
- Moving Newhaven and Seaford into a Brighton Kemptown and Seahaven constituency.
- Moving Higham ward from Gravesham to Rochester and Strood constituency.
- The scale of change proposed in Thanet.
- Moving areas on the outskirts of Tunbridge Wells to a Tonbridge constituency.
- Moving Ticehurst to a Mid Kent and Ticehurst constituency.

#### West Sussex

- There were no major issues that drew objections in this sub-region, but neither was there any significant support other than from the Conservative and Labour parties.



## Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes

- The inclusion of two Milton Keynes borough wards from Stony Stratford, Tattenhoe or Wolverton in the Buckingham constituency.

## Hampshire, Portsmouth, and Southampton

- Moving Colden Common and Twyford ward, and part of Compton Otterbourne ward, from Winchester to Test Valley.
- Moving the two Hart District wards of Church Crookham from North East Hampshire to Aldershot.
- Moving villages south and east of Andover from North West Hampshire to Test Valley.
- Moving the Test Valley Borough Council wards of either Blackwater and Dun Valley, or Chilworth, Nursling and Rownhams to the New Forest East constituency.

## Isle of Wight

- Including East Cowes ward in the Isle of Wight West constituency.

## Oxfordshire

- Separating those parts of Bicester which lie outside its ring road, and local villages in the vicinity.

Final recommendations

10. In light the of the representations and evidence received we have considered whether the revised proposals should be changed.

11. The final recommendations have been formulated using the same sub-regions as the revised proposals. A small number of respondents suggested alternative sub-regions including Hampshire with Surrey, Brighton and Hove with East and West Sussex, and Berkshire with Oxfordshire. We considered these and feel they do not provide for any better solutions than the sub-regions above. We also received counter-proposals crossing regional boundaries, combining Hampshire and Wiltshire, Oxfordshire and South Northamptonshire, and Milton Keynes and South Northamptonshire. We have considered the evidence for these, and feel that they do not meet the exceptional and compelling case required to cross regional boundaries.

12. Under the final recommendations 21 of the existing constituencies are unchanged, and increase of six compared to the initial proposals, and one more than in the revised proposals. Two constituencies are proposed to cross county boundaries, both unchanged from the revised proposals.

## Overview

13. In our initial proposals, we divided the South East region into eight sub-regions: Berkshire; Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes; Brighton and Hove, East Sussex, Kent, and Medway; West Sussex; Hampshire, Portsmouth, and Southampton; Isle of Wight; Oxfordshire; and Surrey. In general, support was received for the creation of these sub-regions during the initial and secondary consultations. Some alternatives were put forward suggesting alternative sub-regions, however, it was considered that most of these did not provide for a better pattern of constituencies. We did consider that a suggestion to combine Berkshire and Surrey as a new sub-region helped to provide a solution to the objections to Chalvey ward being allocated to the Windsor constituency. This sub-region was included in the revised proposals and is retained in our final recommendations.

## Sub-region 1 - Berkshire and Surrey

### Berkshire

14. Of the eight existing constituencies in the ceremonial county of Berkshire, four (Bracknell, Maidenhead, Slough, and Wokingham) are within the permitted electorate range. Of the remaining four constituencies, Newbury is above the permitted range and Reading East, Reading West, and Windsor are below. Our initial proposals were for eight constituencies, and we kept the Bracknell and Maidenhead constituencies unchanged.
15. The revised proposals in the Berkshire part of the sub-region amended the composition of five constituencies we proposed as part of the initial proposals. Objections had previously been received which suggested that the initial proposals divided the centre of Slough and that Chalvey ward should remain in the Slough constituency. Consequently,

it was proposed that the Chalvey ward be included in the Slough constituency, and that the Surrey Heath ward of Windlesham should be included in the Windsor constituency. This allowed us to retain Slough as an unchanged constituency. Objections were also received to the inclusion of the Aldermaston ward and exclusion of the Maiden Erlegh ward from the Wokingham constituency. Respondents considered we were dividing each ward from their most appropriate areas. For the revised proposals, we allocated the Aldermaston ward to the Newbury constituency, and Maiden Erlegh ward to the Wokingham constituency, returning Wokingham to its existing configuration. We also received objections to the inclusion of Mapledurham ward in the Reading West constituency, because it is detached from the remainder of the constituency, and can only be reached by travelling through the Reading East constituency. Our revised proposals allocated Mapledurham ward to the Reading East constituency, and further consequent changes were made to bring Reading East, Reading West and Newbury within the permitted electorate range.

## Surrey

16. Of the eleven constituencies currently in Surrey, eight (East Surrey, Epsom and Ewell, Guildford, Mole Valley, Reigate, South West Surrey, Surrey Heath, and Woking) are within the permitted electorate range. Runnymede and Weybridge, and Spelthorne, have electorates below the range, and the electorate of Esher and Walton is above. Our initial proposals were for eleven constituencies, and we retained East Surrey, Epsom and Ewell, Guildford, Reigate, and South West Surrey unchanged
17. The revised proposals in the Surrey part of the sub-region amended seven of the constituencies from the initial proposals. In addition to the change to Surrey Heath mentioned above, our revised proposals included moving Hersham South ward to the Runnymede and Weybridge constituency, Bisley ward to Surrey Heath constituency, Oxshott and

Stoke D'Abernon to the Esher and Walton constituency, Thorpe ward to the Spelthorne constituency, and Byfleet to the Woking constituency. This allowed us to retain the existing Mole Valley and Woking constituencies unchanged.

## Recommendations

18. The revised proposals have been supported and opposed by respondents during the recent consultation. In addition to the major issues mentioned above, the proposed constituencies of Reading East and Slough were supported by members of the public and, apart from the inclusion of the Windlesham ward in the Windsor constituency, the sub-region was supported by both the Conservative Party and Labour Party. A number of alternative constituency names were also suggested during the recent consultation.
19. The inclusion in the Reading West constituency of the West Berkshire wards of Basildon and Bucklebury was opposed due to both wards being of a more rural nature than the rest of the constituency and being separated from the administrative centre of their local authority. Bucklebury ward is also very close to that centre, Newbury.
20. The Commission received some counter-proposals to the inclusion of the Windlesham ward in the Windsor constituency. These counter-proposals suggested alternative wards that could be included in the Windsor constituency from Bracknell. Some of the wards suggested were Ascot, Bullbrook, Crown Wood, and Priestwood and Garth. Given the opposition received the Commissioner and team visited the areas to assess the evidence on the ground.
21. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region, we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this sub-region. We recognise that some representations received during the recent consultation support changes to both the sub-region makeup, and to individual



constituencies, in particular the transfer of Windlesham ward into the Windsor constituency. However, while we recognise the strength of feeling generated in Windlesham, on the basis of the evidence and the site visit we do not consider that the main alternatives (dividing Slough or Bracknell) would provide for a better reflection of the local community ties, nor indeed the balance of the statutory factors. We consider that the new evidence received is not sufficiently compelling to persuade us to modify the revised proposals for Berkshire and Surrey constituencies. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

## Sub-region 2 - Brighton and Hove, East Sussex, Kent, and Medway

### Brighton and Hove, and East Sussex

22. Of the existing eight constituencies in Brighton and Hove, and East Sussex, the constituencies of Battle and Bexhill, Eastbourne, and Hastings and Rye are within the permitted electorate range. Brighton Kemptown, Brighton Pavillion, Hove, and Lewes constituencies are all below the permitted electorate range. The electorate of the Wealden constituency is above the range. Our initial proposals were for eight constituencies, retaining Eastbourne, and Hastings and Rye unchanged from their existing configurations, and included a High Weald constituency which crossed the county boundary with Kent.
23. Our initial proposals for the City of Brighton and Hove were the most heavily opposed across the South East, with several different counter-proposals presented during the initial and secondary consultations. We considered options extending the three Brighton and Hove constituencies to Shoreham and/or Lewes, rather than to Seaford as in the initial proposals. We also considered the counter-proposals that suggested the splitting of Queen's Park and/or Regency wards between constituencies, and also alternative configurations for the Hove constituency. The assistant

commissioners visited the area in order to observe the different counter-proposals.. We also received some opposition to the geographic size of our proposed High Weald, and Lewes and Uckfield constituencies.

24. The revised proposals made changes to accommodate these concerns. The Brighton Pavillion, and Hove constituencies were more closely aligned to the existing constituencies. The Brighton Kemptown and Seahaven proposal could not include all of the wards of Newhaven and remain within the permitted electorate range when using whole wards. The Commission considered whether the assistant commissioners' suggestion to split Newhaven Denton and Meeching ward met the exceptional and compelling test, and considered that it did not, on the basis of the evidence provided in response to the first two consultations. Instead the revised proposals included the Newhaven Valley ward in a geographically smaller Lewes and Uckfield constituency. Bexhill and Battle was proposed to be more closely aligned to the existing constituency, and the cross-county constituency was proposed to be a less extensive Tunbridge Wells and Crowborough formation. We also added a second cross-county constituency: Mid Kent and Ticehurst.
25. Responses from the final consultation period were similar to those from earlier stages. Some respondents objected and commented that we had the boundary between Brighton and Hove in the wrong place, this time including Regency ward in the wrong constituency, that we were cutting Brighton Pavillion off from the seafront, and others argued strongly that our revised proposals divided Newhaven. Some counter-proposals repeated the arguments from the initial proposals consultation, suggesting that we cross the boundary into West Sussex, pair Lewes with a Brighton constituency, or split one or two wards on the Brighton seafront. Given the strength of argument regarding the breaking of local ties in Newhaven, we gave serious consideration to the ward split option in Queen's Park ward as suggested by the Green and Pirate parties in earlier consultation responses. Not only would it allow the unification of Newhaven within a single constituency but, when taking account of issues further east, in East Sussex and Kent, it would also help to avoid crossing the East Sussex and Kent county boundary, by removing the need to allocate Horam ward to the Bexhill and

Battle constituency, and Ticehurst and Etchingham ward to the Mid Kent and Ticehurst constituency. This allows Bexhill and Battle constituency to remain unchanged, providing a further benefit.

26. The lead commissioner for the region visited the Queen's Park ward, in order to establish whether the ward split proposed by the Green Party was appropriate. They proposed including polling districts EY and EZ into the Brighton Pavilion constituency. They considered this would reunite the Hanover area of the city as well as allowing Newhaven Valley to be united with the other Newhaven wards. On observing the nature of these two polling districts, and neighbouring ones, EW and EX, the commissioner asked that we check whether these two could serve as an alternative to EY and EZ. Mathematically they are suitable, but on checking other representations in the area, we also found that the Pirate Party had suggested all four polling districts be included in Brighton Pavilion constituency. This solution would satisfy representations calling on us to reunite the Hanover area, and to give all three Brighton and Hove constituencies direct access to the seafront.
27. Our revised proposals for Eastbourne, and Lewes and Uckfield, were supported and opposed in the East Dean and Friston areas. We also received objections to our proposals for the boundary between our Bexhill and Battle, and Tunbridge Wells and Crowborough constituencies, and between Tonbridge, and Tunbridge Wells and Crowborough. The inclusion of Ticehurst and Etchingham ward in a cross county constituency was also heavily opposed. As noted above, the division of the Queen's Park ward would enable the Commission to address some of these objections. A number of alternative constituency names were also suggested during the recent consultation.

## Recommendations

28. Having considered the evidence and having discussed this with the lead commissioner, we recommend that Queen's Park ward be split, with polling districts EW, EX, EY and EZ being included in the Brighton Pavilion constituency, and polling districts ER, ES, ET, EU and EV, and the Newhaven Valley ward be included in the Brighton Kempton and Seahaven constituency. We consider that there are exception and compelling reasons that justify this ward split, given the fact that it addresses the arguments around local ties in Newhaven, access issues in Brighton, and avoids significant knock-on effects through East Sussex and Kent. We recommend that Horam ward is allocated to the Lewes and Uckfield constituency and that this be called Lewes and West Wealden, due to evidence received during the final consultation period. We recommend that Ticehurst and Etchingham ward is allocated to the Bexhill and Battle constituency, returning this last constituency to its existing configuration and removing the second crossing of the East Sussex and Kent boundary. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

## Kent and Medway

29. There are currently 17 constituencies in the ceremonial County of Kent. Dartford, Dover, Rochester and Strood, Sittingbourne and Sheppey, and Tonbridge and Malling are within the permitted electorate range. Ashford, Canterbury, Chatham and Aylesford, Faversham and Mid Kent, and Folkestone and Hythe constituencies have too many electors, and Gillingham and Rainham, Gravesham, Maidstone and The Weald, North Thanet, Sevenoaks, South Thanet, and Tunbridge Wells constituencies all have too few. As so many are below the range, our initial proposals included 16 constituencies, retaining just Sittingbourne and Sheppey in its existing configuration.

30. Our initial proposals were both supported and opposed. A counter-proposal to retain Higham ward in the Gravesham constituency was supported, as were our proposals for Chatham and The Mallings, Dartford, Gillingham and Rainham, Sevenoaks, and Sittingbourne and Sheppey. Our proposal to include Lordswood and Capstone ward in the Gillingham and Rainham constituency was opposed, as this would break community ties with the Princes Park and Walderslade wards. Similarly, our proposal to include Wateringbury ward in a Chatham and The Mallings constituency was opposed due to its links with Tonbridge to the west.
31. There was opposition to our initial proposals for Tonbridge and The Weald constituency. Respondents felt that it was poorly aligned to both the existing Tonbridge and Malling constituency and Tonbridge and Malling District Council. It was also considered that the town of Edenbridge, allocated to the Sevenoaks constituency in our initial proposals, looked towards Tonbridge for schools due to its road and rail links in that direction. A small amendment to our Maidstone proposal was suggested, to add Park Wood ward to the constituency, in order to increase the number of urban Maidstone wards in the constituency.
32. In east Kent, our proposal to include Little Stour and Ashstone, and Sandwich wards in the Dover constituency was both supported and opposed. Respondents variously reported that Sandwich has links either south to Dover, or north towards Thanet, and that Little Stour and Ashstone looks towards Canterbury, or Sandwich and Thanet. Our initial proposals for North Kent Coastal, and Thanet East constituencies were both supported and opposed. Opposition was focused on where the boundary between these two constituencies should lie, with a view to keeping the existing South Thanet constituency intact.
33. There was little comment on our initial proposals for the Ashford, Canterbury and Faversham, and Folkestone and Hythe constituencies.

34. As part of our revised proposals we modified our Sevenoaks proposal, to include Wrotham, Ightham and Stansted, instead of two Edenbridge wards, which we allocated to Tonbridge. We also further modified our Tonbridge proposal, allocating the more geographically distant wards to our Mid Kent and Ticehurst proposal. We were persuaded by the evidence regarding Park Wood ward, and added it to the Maidstone constituency.
35. We were convinced by the evidence regarding Higham ward remaining in Gravesham, allowing us to retain Rochester and Strood as a constituency unchanged from its existing configuration. We considered the evidence regarding Wateringbury ward to be sufficient to transfer it from our initial Chatham and The Mallings proposal to our Tonbridge constituency.
36. We considered the evidence in respect of our east Kent proposals, and modified them to include Sandwich in the East Thanet and Sandwich constituency, and to move the boundary between that and the North Kent Coastal constituency. The revised boundary proposed a different division in Margate and resulted in the majority of Margate, Broadstairs and Ramsgate being included in a single constituency. Consequently, we allocated Seasalter to the Canterbury and Faversham constituency, and Little Stour and Ashstone to the Dover and Deal constituency to ensure all the constituencies were within the permitted electorate range.
37. As our initial proposals for Ashford, Dartford, Eastbourne, Folkestone and Hythe, Gillingham and Rainham, Hastings and Rye, and Sittingbourne and Sheppey were largely supported, we made no changes to these for our revised proposals.

38. In response to the consultation on our revised proposals we received opposition and support across Kent. We received objections to our proposals for the boundary between Tonbridge, and Tunbridge Wells and Crowborough constituencies. There was both support and objection for our revised proposals in north and east Kent. Splitting Seasalter from Whitstable was strongly opposed, as respondents considered these form a continuous residential area. Residents of Little Stour and Ashstone felt that their links are with Canterbury and Sandwich, but that it has poor transport links with Dover. Responses about Margate and Ramsgate repeated concerns from earlier consultations. Evidence regarding Sandwich ward indicates that it looks both north to Ramsgate, and south to Dover. The overall pattern of constituencies here did also receive some support.
39. The close proximity of Tonbridge and Tunbridge Wells made our considerations here difficult, and we concluded that no further change was possible without causing undesirable knock-on effects to neighbouring constituencies.
40. A number of alternative constituency names were also suggested during the recent consultation.

#### Recommendations

41. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend some changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this part of the sub-region. We note that representations received during this consultation in Kent have strongly opposed the division of Seasalter from Whitstable, and so we recommend that Seasalter is allocated to the North Kent Coastal constituency. We also note concerns regarding Little Stour and Ashstone ward, and recommend that it be allocated to the Canterbury and Faversham constituency, and Sandwich ward is allocated to the Dover and Deal constituency. Therefore, these proposals largely revert to the initial proposals, subject to the inclusion of Little Stour and Ashtone in the Canterbury and Faversham constituency, and

Eythorne and Shepherdsweil in the Dover and Deal constituency. The rest of the sub-region remains as in our revised proposals, subject to Ticehurst and Etchingam ward being retained in the existing Bexhill and Battle constituency. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

### Sub-region 3 - West Sussex

42. Of the eight existing constituencies in West Sussex, five are currently within the permitted electorate range, Crawley has too few electors, and Chichester, and Mid Sussex have too many. Under our initial proposals we proposed to retain the existing constituency of East Worthing and Shoreham completely unchanged, and changes to the West Worthing constituency were limited to that needed to accommodate ward boundary changes in the District of Arun. Other changes across the county were relatively minor.
43. In order to bring our proposed Chichester constituency within the permitted electorate range, we proposed the transfer of Plaistow ward to the Arundel and South Downs constituency. We also proposed transferring Bolney ward from the Mid Sussex constituency to Arundel and South Downs. As this left Arundel and South Downs outside the permitted electorate range, we proposed to transfer Barnham ward to the Bognor Regis and Littlehampton constituency. To increase the number of electors in the Crawley constituency, we proposed to include Cophorne and Worth ward from the Horsham constituency.
44. In response to the consultations on our initial proposals, most respondents were supportive of the proposed constituencies in West Sussex, with a relatively small number of objections.



45. There was some debate about whether Rusper and Colgate ward should, either in total or just part, be added to the Crawley constituency, rather than Copthorne and Worth ward, due in part to the perceived barrier presented by the M23, and development work ongoing in Rusper and Colgate ward, where it borders Crawley. We noted that Rusper and Colgate also borders Horsham town, which Copthorne and Worth does not.
46. Having considered the small number of objections to our initial proposals, and their potential impact on what was a sub-region with only limited changes to existing constituencies, we made no changes for the revised proposals.
47. In response to the consultation on our revised proposals we received some support for the pattern of constituencies. There were no large scale objections. We did receive some locally focused objections from a small number of representations, such as asking that Crawley Down and Turners Hill ward, or Hassock ward be included in the Mid Sussex constituency. Resolving these would have created undesirable knock-on effects beyond the immediate issue raised by the respondent.

#### Recommendations

48. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this sub-region. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

#### Sub-region 4 - Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes

49. Of the seven constituencies in this subregion, four (Aylesbury, Beaconsfield, Buckingham, and Wycombe) are within the permitted electorate range, Milton Keynes North and Milton Keynes South have too many electors, and Chesham and Amersham has too few. Of the four that are within the range, we were able to retain the existing Beaconsfield constituency.
50. As Milton Keynes borough has too many electors for two constituencies, but not enough for three, two of its wards had to be allocated to a neighbouring constituency. As part of the initial proposals, we decided to include the wards of Stony Stratford and Wolverton in the Buckingham constituency.
51. During the consultation on our initial proposals, we received both support and objection in this sub-region. Much of the opposition focused on including Milton Keynes wards in a Buckingham constituency. The only alternative to this would be to cross the region boundary, and include Milton Keynes wards in either an East Midlands or Eastern region constituency. We did receive counter-proposals suggesting this but, in discussion with teams for those regions, none of these provided improved solutions in those regions, and so we found they did not have exceptional or compelling evidence to do so.
52. We received a small number of representations that Lacey Green, Speen and the Hampdens ward has links with The Risboroughs ward and to Wycombe, and that The Risboroughs has links to Aylesbury, rather than to Chesham and Amersham or Buckingham, as in the Commission's initial proposals. However, a suggested attempt to address this in a counter-proposal relied upon splitting the Hazlemere wards between Chesham and Amersham, and Wycombe constituencies.

53. The only change made for the revised proposals was to allocate the Milton Keynes Borough ward of Tattenhoe to the Buckingham constituency instead of Wolverton ward, in accordance with the evidence received.
54. Responses during the final consultation period covered much of the same material as during the earlier periods. With respect to Tattenhoe ward, respondents indicated that, although Tattenhoe is on a direct road to Buckingham, as a more recent development it had always been part of Milton Keynes. Respondents suggested that the Wolverton ward, as one of the pre-Milton Keynes villages, had a separate identity as the Wolverton Urban District until 1974. This also included the neighbouring Stony Stratford area. Although these wards are separated by the A5, they are joined by Millers Way and Stratford Road. Both areas had been part of the Buckingham constituency from at least 1918 until 1992. The respondents suggested that we should revert to the initial proposals for Buckinghamshire in the Milton Keynes and Buckinghamshire area. A number of alternative constituency names were also suggested during the recent consultation.

## Recommendations

55. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend changing our proposals for the final recommendations. On the basis of the evidence received, we recommend reverting to our initial proposals, in that the two Milton Keynes wards of Stony Stratford and Wolverton be added to the Buckingham constituency, and Tattenhoe ward should be allocated to the Milton Keynes South constituency. We also recommend that two constituencies be renamed: Buckingham to be renamed Buckingham and Milton Keynes West, and Milton Keynes South West to be renamed Milton Keynes South. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

## Sub-region 5 - Hampshire, Portsmouth, and Southampton

56. Of the 18 existing constituencies in this sub-region, eight (Basingstoke, Eastleigh, Fareham, Gosport, Meon Valley, New Forest East, North East Hampshire, and North West Hampshire) have electorates within the permitted electorate range. The remaining ten constituencies (Aldershot, East Hampshire, Havant, New Forest West, Portsmouth North, Portsmouth South, Southampton Itchen, Southampton Test, Test Valley, and Winchester) all have too few electors. Our initial proposals reduced the number of constituencies for this sub-region to 17 and, we proposed retaining three existing constituencies unchanged, Basingstoke, Eastleigh and Gosport.
57. Our initial proposals were both supported and opposed. Of the national parties, Labour and the Liberal Democrats supported the initial proposals for Hampshire in their entirety, while the Conservatives put forward a different configuration of constituencies in Southampton (still retaining both seats within the city boundaries).
58. There was opposition to the proposal to include the Dun Valley and Blackwater wards in the New Forest East constituency, with evidence put forward that residents look instead to Romsey, Andover, Salisbury or Winchester, rather than south to the New Forest communities, with the east-west nature of roads in the area being highlighted. Counter-proposals put forward were to either cross the regional boundary into Wiltshire (for which we saw no justification), or to substitute for these two wards the ward of Chilworth, Nursling and Rownhams. There were also objections to the inclusion of Compton and Otterbourne ward and Colden Common and Twyford ward in the proposed Test Valley constituency, with counter-proposals either splitting the Compton and Otterbourne ward (to keep the polling district containing Compton and Shawford parish with Winchester), or substituting for both wards the two wards of Sparsholt and Wonston and Micheldever.

59. In north east Hampshire, there was strong local opposition to moving the two Church Crookham wards into Aldershot, which focused on how this separated them from Fleet, with which they are said to have closer ties. Counter-proposals suggested instead adding the Yateley East ward to the existing Aldershot, which would split the village of Yateley. There was also opposition to excluding villages such as Abbots Ann and Amport close to Andover from the North West Hampshire constituency, to where they naturally gravitate, and allocating Alton wards to North East Hampshire, separated from the rest of East Hampshire District Council.
60. There was both support and opposition to our initial proposals for Portsmouth North and South, with debate focused on which ward to add to Portsmouth South, and where to expand Portsmouth North beyond the city boundary, to ensure both fell within the permitted electorate range. Moving either of Baffins and Nelson wards would bring Portsmouth South within the permitted electorate range, and we received representations in favour of both options. Further representations called for us to expand Portsmouth North to the north or west, rather than to the east as in our initial proposals.
61. For our revised proposals, in relation to the New Forest East constituency, we were persuaded by the evidence put forward in favour of retaining the Dun Valley and Blackwater wards in a Test Valley constituency, moving instead the ward of Chilworth, Nursling and Rownhams into New Forest East, given the evidence received regarding closer links between the areas. As it was a finely balanced decisions, we invited respondents to comment on this specifically during the consultation on the revised proposals. While recognising the community links between Winchester and areas to its south and west, we noted that the counter-proposals would result in cutting other community ties, and therefore kept the initial proposals for the boundaries unchanged in this area. Similarly, we did not recommend adopting counter-proposals put forward for the Aldershot constituency. We recognised that the initial proposals split Church Crookham from Fleet, but that the counter-proposals would split the town of Yateley. We were not able to accommodate changes to include the Andover villages in the North West Hampshire constituency, as to do so would have caused greater disruption to the

Test Valley and Winchester constituencies, and beyond. We felt that the evidence received regarding Portsmouth indicated Baffins ward to be the better fit for Portsmouth South, but that the case for changes to the northern extent of Portsmouth North was not sufficient to make further change there.

62. Response to the final consultation mirrored those from earlier stages, with repeats of issues to the south of Andover and Winchester, around Fleet and Aldershot, and as to which ward or wards to include in the New Forest East constituency. Of these, only the New Forest East issue can be resolved without substantial disruption to the sub-region. On considering the evidence from all consultation stages, we consider that including Blackwater and Dun Valley wards is a better fit than Chilworth, Nursling and Rownhams ward. While all three wards look towards Romsey, so in an ideal world none would be allocated to New Forest East constituency, Chilworth, Nursling and Rownhams ward is detached from New Forest East constituency, with all the connecting roads passing through neighbouring constituencies. It is also a more built up area than the rural Blackwater and Dun Valley wards, and so more like the neighbouring Chandlers Ford and North Baddesley areas.

## Recommendations

63. Having considered the evidence with the lead commissioner for the region, we have concluded that the only change appropriate for Hampshire is to revert to our initial proposals for New Forest East and Test Valley constituencies due to the strength of evidence received at this stage. All other proposals remain as in the revised proposals. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

## Sub-region 6 - Isle of Wight

64. The Isle of Wight sub-region is unique in England in that we are required to allocate two constituencies to it, and that neither are required to be within the permitted electorate range. Our initial proposals were for Isle of Wight East and Isle of Wight West constituencies, each with a similar number of electors, 52,180 West and 53,268 East.
65. During consultation on our initial proposals, most of the opposition to our proposals for the Isle of Wight was about the principle of splitting the island. This is a statutory requirement under the legislation, so these views were set aside. The east-west split of the island received both support and opposition, with a small number of responses suggesting a north-south split.
66. For the revised proposals, we decided to modify the constituencies by including the Wootton Bridge electoral division in the Isle of Wight East constituency instead of to Isle of Wight West.
67. Responses to the final consultation indicated a desire locally that East Cowes be included in Isle of Wight East, as its ties are with Ryde to the east. Respondents indicated that the River Medina was a divider in this area which separated East Cowes from West Cowes. This modification would also require the Whippingham and Osborne electoral division to be included in the Isle of Wight West constituency. This brings the electorate of the two island constituencies further away from the parity we sought at the initial proposal stage, 43,459 West and 61,989 East.

## Recommendations

68. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend that East Cowes and Whippingham and Osborne electoral divisions be included in the Isle of Wight East constituency. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.

### Sub-region 7 - Oxfordshire

69. Of the six existing constituencies in Oxfordshire, two are above the permitted electorate range (Banbury, and Wantage) and one (Oxford East) is below. The remaining three constituencies (Henley, Oxford West and Abingdon, and Witney) are within the range. The initial proposals retained the existing Witney constituency unchanged.
70. The initial proposals for Oxfordshire received a mixture of support and opposition during the first two consultations. The main objection was to separating the villages and suburbs closest to Bicester away from the town. Representations considered this could be resolved by either crossing the region boundary into South Northamptonshire, or by a more disruptive rearrangement of north Oxfordshire, neither of which was felt to be justified by the evidence presented. In particular, the cross-region counter-proposal suggested provided no assistance in developing a good arrangement of constituencies in South Northamptonshire. We also received objections to moving Wallingford ward out of the Wantage constituency, across the natural boundary that is the Thames, and some objections to the boundaries of the two Oxford constituencies.
71. In developing the revised proposals, the assistant commissioners visited Oxford, the towns and villages to the south and east, and Wallingford, to observe the nature of wards in these areas. In Oxford they compared the nature of the



Wolvercote, Summertown, St Margaret's, North, and Jericho and Osney wards. It did appear that Jericho and Osney ward is of a very similar nature to the central Oxford wards.

72. The assistant commissioners also observed the very rural nature of the wards of Wheatley, Garsington and Horspath, and Sandford and The Wittenhams mitigated against transferring them to the much more urban Oxford East constituency, as per the Liberal Democrats counter-proposal, or to Oxford West and Abingdon, as per the Commission's initial proposal, in addition to their poor road links to Abingdon.
73. The revised proposals took account of this evidence and placed the wards of Wheatley, Garsington and Horspath, and Sandford and The Wittenhams in our proposed East Oxfordshire constituency, Wallingford ward in the Wantage constituency, and Jericho and Osney, and North wards in the Oxford constituency.
74. During the final consultation period, we received similar opposition to earlier consultations regarding the separation of Bicester villages and suburbs from the town, and to what is perceived by some respondents as the artificial pairing of Abingdon with areas to the north of Oxford, their only link being the A34 road, but we see no way of resolving these concerns without substantial disruption across the sub-region.

## Recommendations

75. Having considered the evidence and following discussions with the lead commissioner for this region we recommend no changes to the boundaries of the revised proposals in this sub-region. We did not consider that new or compelling evidence had been received regarding the issues raised across the county. The names and composition of each constituency for the final recommendations is detailed in appendix A.
