Thank you for your FOI request of 6 July 2020 to the Boundary Commission for England (BCE) under the provision of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

As your request is so straightforward, I am sending a full reply now, rather than later within the statutory statutory 20 day period.

You have asked:

1. The Boundary Commission for England currently employs 3 part-time staff. This equates to a full-time staff equivalent of 1.4 people.

I am not able to provide answers to the remainder of the questions asked because this is not information that the BCE holds or compiles. The BCE is a small, arms-length body: all of its IT and support is provided to it by the Cabinet Office, and the BCE uses the Cabinet Office intranet.
