Thank you for your email request for information to the Boundary Commission for England (BCE) on 5 November, which has been considered under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

In your request for information you asked:

I'd like to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act for all of your entity's transactions over £25000 for April to September 2025.

Our response:

The Boundary Commission for England carries out regular reviews of Parliamentary constituencies boundaries. The last review concluded in 2023, and the next is planned to begin in 2029. During the period between reviews, the Commission is largely dormant. We have no transactions above £25,000 for the period April to September 2025.
